



Graduate and Post Master's Certificate Nursing Professional Licensure Disclosure

Norwich University offers a Master of Science in Nursing and a Post-Master's Certificate with concentrations in Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner, Family Nurse Practitioner, and Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner. These programs are designed to prepare students to sit for certification in one of these concentrations and apply for a license to practice.

This disclosure states whether these programs, if successfully completed, meet the applicable educational requirements for advanced practice licensure or certification in each state and territory. The information is strictly limited to Norwich's determination.

This disclosure does not provide any guarantee that any particular state or territory licensure or certification board will approve or deny an application. In addition, Norwich cannot verify an individual's ability to meet licensure or certification requirements unrelated to its educational programs.

For Post-Masters Certifications, Norwich cannot guarantee that pathophysiology, pharmacology, or health/physical assessment courses taken at other institutions will fulfill state or certification body requirements. Applicants are responsible for verifying with the state board of nursing in their intended practice state and the specialty certifying body to ensure that any courses transferred into a Norwich University School of Nursing program meet the necessary requirements for licensure or certification.
